AGREEMENT

No. 3955

This Agreement made this 3rd day of September 1901 between Charles H. Allger, H.H. Allger, A.J. Allger & Wm. J. Stubbs, parties of the first part and Marion S. Berry party of the second part, Witnesseth, That

Whereas, first & second parties are the owners of the "Lady of the Lake" steamer on Lake Chelan, Washington, and

Whereas, first parties are desirous of mortgaging same in the sum of \$1500.00 to cover certain indebtedness against said steamer,

Now, therefore, in consideration of said second party entering into said mortgage agreement said first parties agree to pay said second party out of the net proceeds of any forced sale thereunder after the payment of said mortgage indebtedness and any other claims then existing against said vessel the sum of one thousand Dollars for his interest in said steamer or whatever sum less than \$1,000 said sale may net.

Said second party in consideration of the premises agrees to sell his interest in said steamer for the sum of \$1,000 in case said first parties obtain a purchaser for same and desire to make a sale thereof while said mortgage remains on said vessel.
